WORM TEA SUGGESTED APPLICATION GUIDE FOR CANNABIS GROWERS

Brew Strength: 1 lb worm castings per gallon (strong concentrate)

PLANT STAGE: SEEDLINGS / CLONES

Week(s): 1–2

How Often: Once at transplant

Dilution: 1 part tea : 4–5 parts water

Amount per plant: ½ to 1 cup (root drench)

Notes: Gentle inoculation; do not foliar spray.

PLANT STAGE: VEGETATIVE

Week(s): 2–8

How Often: Every 7–14 days

Dilution: 1 part tea : 1–2 parts water

Amount per plant: ½ to 1 gallon (root drench)

Foliar spray (optional): Every 14 days

Dilution for foliar: 1 part tea : 4–5 parts water

Foliar amount: 1–2 cups per plant (fine mist)

Notes: Spray in early AM or just after lights-off.

PLANT STAGE: EARLY FLOWER

Week(s): 1–2 of flower

How Often: 1–2 times total

Dilution: 1 part tea : 1 part water

Amount per plant: ½ to 1 gallon (root drench)

Foliar spray (optional): Once only in Week 1

Dilution for foliar: 1 part tea : 4–5 parts water

Notes: Stop foliar spraying after Week 2 to avoid moisture on buds.

PLANT STAGE: MID–LATE FLOWER

Week(s): 3–8 of flower

Worm Tea Use: None

Notes: Do not apply tea to avoid mold or excess moisture in buds.

GENERAL BREWING & USE NOTES:

- Always dilute strong tea before applying.
- Use dechlorinated or rainwater for dilution.
- Only apply to moist or slightly dry soil — avoid overwatering.
- Strain thoroughly before any foliar spray.
- Use within 12–24 hours of brewing for full microbial benefit.
- Store in shade and avoid refrigeration or sealed storage.

SUGGESTED WEEKLY USAGE BY GROW SIZE:

Small Grow (4–6 plants):

2–4 gallons diluted tea per week

Larger Grow (8–10 plants):

4–6 gallons diluted tea per week
